The third multidisciplinary European DLM-Forum on electronic records will take place in Barcelona on 7 and 8 May 2002.

The DLM-Forum 2002 will welcome specialists and executives representing different disciplines: public administration, archives, the ICT-industry and research. A large number of participants from the EU Member States, regions, candidate states and other European countries are expected.

The DLM-Forum 2002 will be organised by the Secretariat for the Information Society of the Catalan government together with other Catalan institutions and departments of the Spanish central government. They benefit from the support of the European Union Presidencies of Sweden (1st half of 2001), Belgium (2nd half 2001) and Spain (1st half of 2002), the European Commission (Secretariat General, DG Information Society) and representatives from the ICT-industry.
