CALL FOR PAPERS

The DLM-Forum 2002 in Barcelona (7-8 May 2002) calls for the submission of original papers and welcomes the participation of experts in the fields of public administration, archives, industry and research.

Scientific committee

The scientific committee of the DLM Forum consists of representatives of the European Union Member States, regions and the European Commission. The scientific committee will evaluate the papers submitted.

Submission of papers

- Proposals for papers submitted to the scientific committee should consist of an **extended abstract** (500-800 words)
- **Complete papers** (2000-4000 words) can also be submitted but must be **accompanied by an abstract** in one of the working languages
- All proposals must be submitted in one of the **working languages** of the DLM-Forum (English, French and German)
- Submissions must include the name(s) and short cv's of the authors and a full address
- Each submission will be examined on the basis of its clarity, quality and adherence to the general theme and/or one of the specific themes of the DLM Forum 2002
- Selected papers will be presented in 30-minute sessions

Deadlines:

a) extended abstract of papers should be submitted to the scientific committee at the address below no later than **30 November 2001**;

b) the completed papers should be submitted no later than **25 March 2002**

All submissions should be submitted in electronic format
